

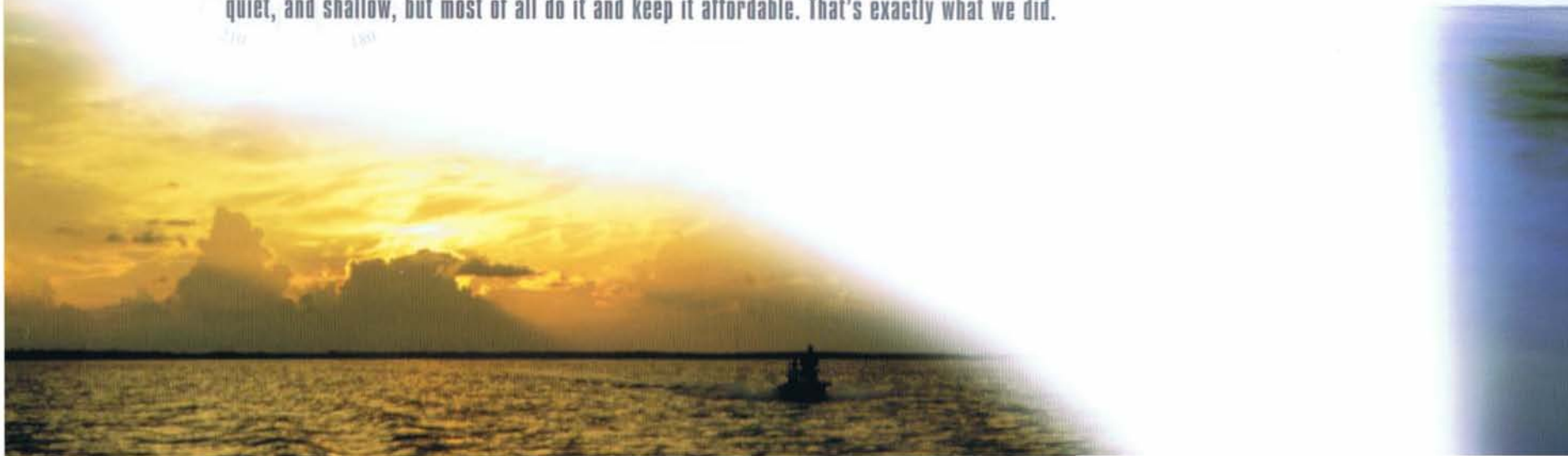

Mitzi Skiffs are fishermen's boats. Serious fishermen's boats. Why? Mitzi Skiffs are designed to stalk fish, period. Sure we designed them to fit other criteria but we are all trying to do the same thing — catch fish. Have you ever heard someone say, "Get out of your boat and wade to the fish...you can get closer." Well, we thought why get out of the boat? Mitzi Skiffs will pole in 6-7 inches of water depending on the bottom, with anglers on board, and do it in absolute dead silence. Mitzi Skiffs get you closer.

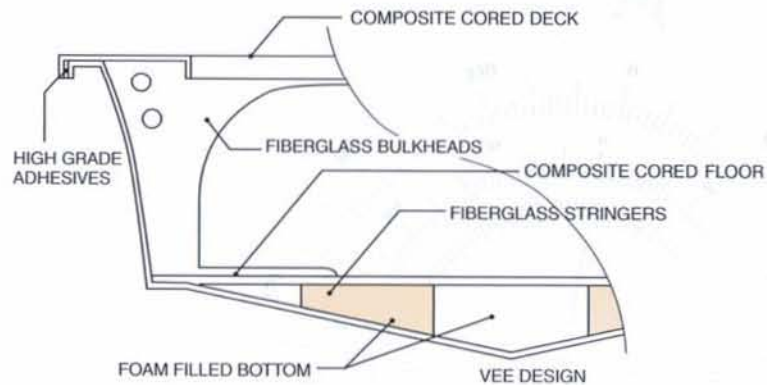

More for less

Mitzi Skiffs give you performance both in the shallows and on the way there because fishermen know that sometimes it's just not so pretty out there. Your Mitzi Skiff will make the run from the fishing grounds far more comfortable and dry than any flat bottomed hull yet gives you the shallow water performance you demand. How you may ask? By engineering the right combination of deadrise (vee) and hull shape. We also engineer our boats as light as possible. Less weight means less power requirements. Why hang more weight on the transom than you need? Less weight also means shallower draft, less fuel consumption and easier handling both on the flats and at the dock. Remember this; you will spend 90% of your time fishing, and poling, etc... not running around. With less power requirements you can pole in shallower water, for longer periods of time with less effort, and get there with less fuel. Less weight, less fuel and less effort in the water. You'll fish longer for less.

Value by design

No wood. That's right, no wood is used in Mitzi Skiff's construction. This means you're getting more for your money. See a boat with wood is going to rot sometime or another, it's a fact of life. Wood decays, just add moisture and oxygen, its that simple. You can glass it all you want but it still eventually rots. Now use foam and what do you get? A boat your kids will still be fishing in. We believe in only using the highest quality materials, laminates and adhesives. Our hulls also have solid foam-filled fiberglass stringers. They don't rot or fall apart, they last. Let's face it, the majority of a small boat's wear is on its bottom. It only makes sense to build a hefty bottom and stringer system to take the beating the water and trailer can dish out. We make it more durable than we need to. Why? We build great shallow water skiffs and want happy owners, period.

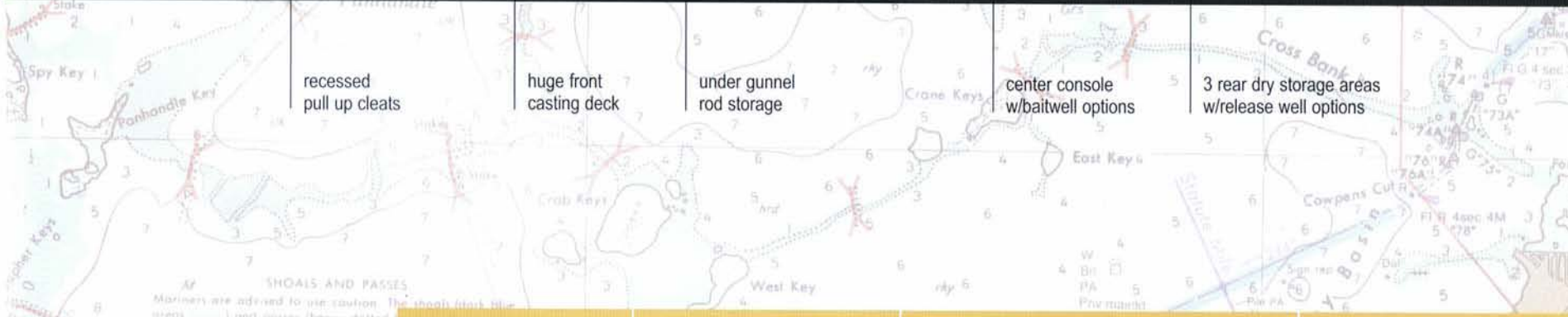
Shallow water ahead — no problem for a Mitzi 16

Want a shallow drafting skiff that hops on plane with ease using a 40? One with tons of storage? One that gets you home dry? Look no further... The Mitzi 16 is the answer to the fisherman looking for a 16' skiff that offers the kind of performance flats fishermen need while poling, and on the way to and from the flats when the

wind picks up. Both the Mitzi 16 and the ST are based on the same sponson type hull in which the transom extends around the outboard — What's this do for the flats fisherman? This allows the boat to have a better hole shot where the transom of the boat does not want to dig down, allowing the boat to hop on plane in

shallower water and quicker. The sponsons also put buoyancy past the outboard to keep the draft shallower. The 16 and ST have a huge amount of storage, in the 3 rear hatches and under the front deck. More than most skiffs of their size.

The ST, the perfect blend of a vee hull ride with the shallow running ability of a tunnel hull. By combining our 16 hull with an engineered tunnel, the ST is the perfect "in between" boat without the bad habits of some tunnel hulls. The ST does not cavitate when turning, and runs a chop as well as any tunnel hull out there.

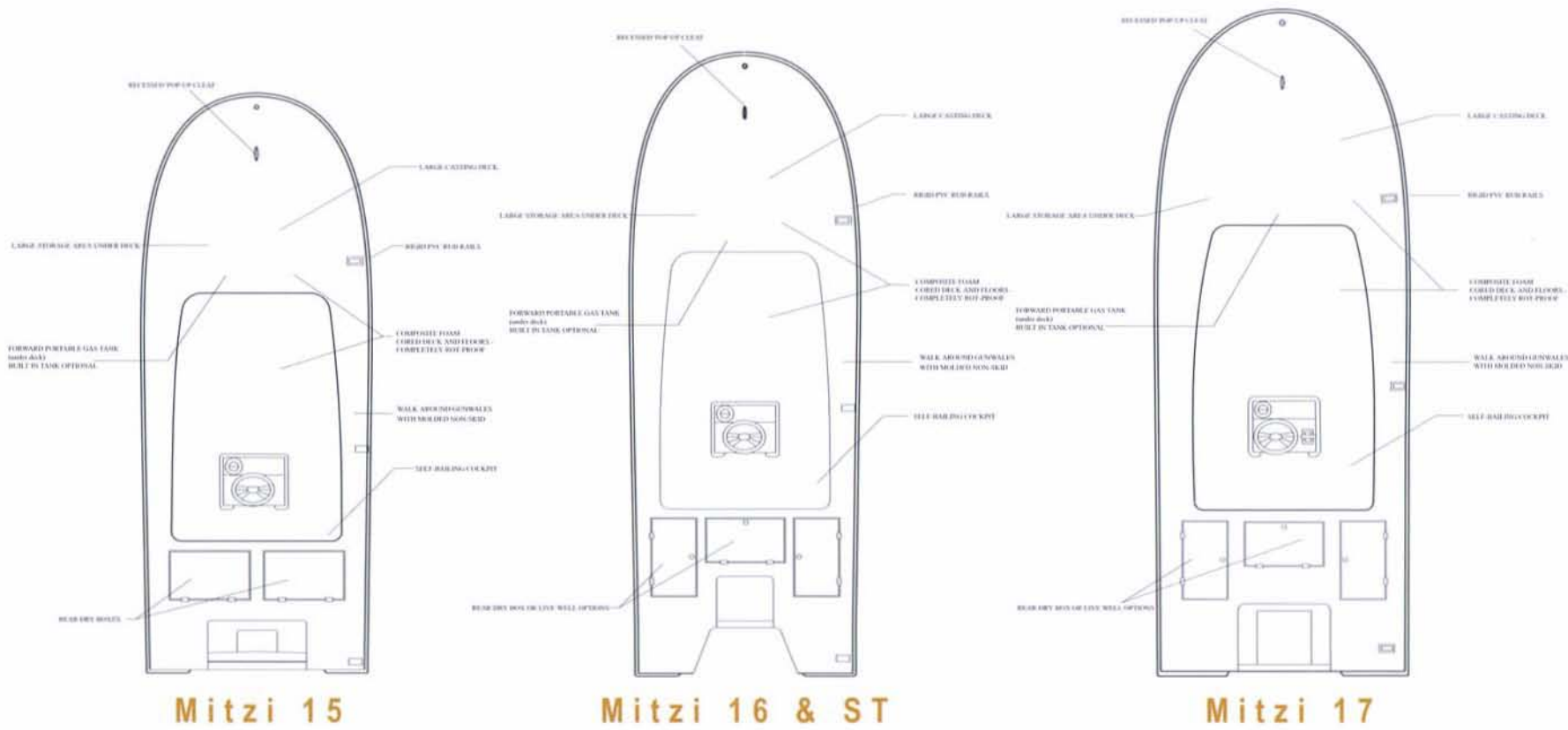

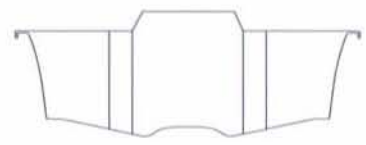
